
Canasta: How to Play Made Easy - The Ultimate Guide for Beginners

Canastas are worth points as follows:

- Natural canasta: 500 points
- Mixed canasta: 300 points

Capturing Cards from Your Opponents

You can capture cards from your opponents by melding them into your own canastas or by taking them from the discard pile.

To meld cards from your opponent's discard pile, you must have a card of the same rank in your hand. You can then take all of the cards from the discard pile that match your card.

To capture cards from your opponent's canastas, you must have a card of the same rank and suit as the top card of the canasta. You can then take all of the cards from the canasta that match your card.

Discarding a Card

If you cannot make a meld or capture any cards, you must discard one card from your hand. You can discard any card, but it is generally best to discard a low-value card.

Winning the Game

The game ends when one player or team reaches 5,000 points. The player or team with the most points at the end of the game wins.


